Who is he that overcomes the world?

1 John 5:5-8

5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?
6 This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.
7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.
8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.

- A. Who is he that overcomes the world? (see 1 John 4:4-6)
- B. What does the bible mean by "water and blood"? (see John 3:3-8 ... "not by water only")
- C. Who does John define as the Trinity that "bear record" in heaven? (see John 1:1-2 ... 12-14)

- D. What does John define as the Trinity that "bear witness" in earth? (see John 1:1-2 ... 12-14)
[these three agree]
- E. Part of the "witness in earth" is "the blood"; what is so significant about his blood?
(see Genesis 4:10, John 19:33-35, Revelation 12:11, Exodus 12:3-11)
