### TODAY'S LESSON

#### HOW BIBLICAL IS GOOD FRIDAY?

Good Friday is a hoax! There is no possible way to reconcile "3 days and 3 nights in the heart of the earth" (Matthew 12:40) with a Friday crucifixion as illustrated to the right! Note that according to the Jews calendar, by the way, "the first day of the week" [Sunday] begins at sunset of what we call Saturday evening. Therefore, Jesus rose anytime from sunset Saturday evening, but before daybreak: this would then be the "first day of the week."

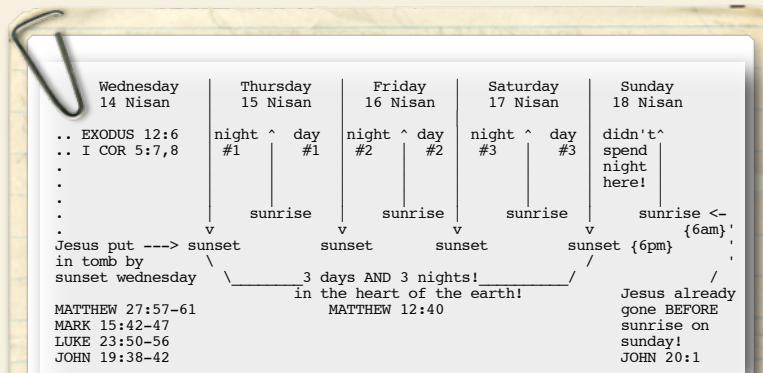
#### A DETAIL OF JESUS' LAST WEEK

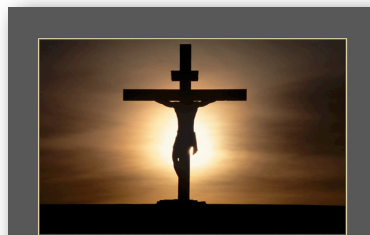

#### LET US KNOW YOUR SCHEDULES

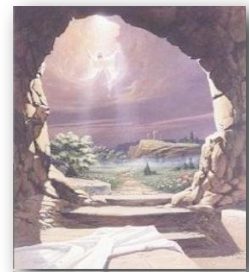
We'd like to start figuring out peoples schedules as we plan for the March C&C event.

Friday 9 Nisan - Before sunset Jesus comes to Bethany : It is 6 days before  
 \*\*\*\*\* passover.

JOHN 12:1

Saturday 10 Nisan - (By gentile reckoning it is Friday evening: just after  
 \*\*\*\*\* sunset) Jesus is anointed for the first time. The  
 passover lamb is set aside.

JOHN 12:2-9 EXODUS 12:3

---

Sunday 11 Nisan - Jesus' Triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

JOHN 12:12-19 MARK 11:1-11 MATTHEW 21:1-11 LUKE 19:28-40

Monday 12 Nisan - Jesus curses fig tree.

\*\*\*\*\*

MARK 11:12-19 MATTHEW 21:17-22{covers 12th and 13th}

Tuesday 13 Nisan - Fig tree withered; Second anointing; Last supper (last  
 \*\*\*\*\* supper by Jewish reckoning is already Wednesday, the day  
 of preparation because it's after sunset)

MARK 11:20 MARK 14:1-9 MATTHEW 26:1-13 MARK 14:10-25

MATTHEW 26:14-29 LUKE 22:1-23 JOHN 13:1-4

---

Wednesday 14 Nisan - (day of preparation) Jesus condemned 6am-9am  
 \*\*\*\*\* Jesus crucified 9am-3pm

Jesus removed from the cross just before 6pm (sunset)  
 and placed in tomb.

MARK 15:1-47 LUKE 22:66-23:56 JOHN 18:27-19:42

MATTHEW 26:57-27:61 EXODUS 12:6 I CORINTHIANS 5:7,8

---

Thursday 15 Nisan - (Beginning at sunset wednesday night, the first day of  
 \*\*\*\*\* unleavened bread) Jesus in tomb.

\* NOTE \* Feast of unleavened bread is called the Passover \* LUKE 22:1

\* REMEMBER \* Each feast begins with a "holy convocation", or "sabbath", or  
 "high day", which is not to be confused with the normal weekly  
 sabbath which is saturday.

EXODUS 12:16 LEVITICUS 23:7 JOHN 19:31{was not saturday, but the first  
 day of the feast!-Thurs 15 Nisan)

Friday 16 Nisan - Jesus in tomb

\*\*\*\*\*

---

Saturday 17 Nisan - (weekly sabbath of rest) Jesus in tomb until at least  
 \*\*\*\*\* 6pm:which is sunset.

---

Sunday 18 Nisan - (first day of the week beginning by Jewish reckoning at  
 \*\*\*\*\* sunset {6pm} saturday) Resurrection occurs between  
 6pm saturday evening and 6am sunday morning.(Most likely  
 nearer to 6pm saturday [see chart below])

MATTHEW 28 MARK 16 LUKE 24 JOHN 20(particularly v.1)

NOTE \* contrast these 4 accounts VERY CAREFULLY: There are two trips  
 made to the tomb by Mary Magdelene. JOHN 20:1- It was yet dark,  
 and notice that the tomb is ALREADY empty!
